“NHLBI Catalyze Program: Providing Bridge from Basic to Clinical Research”

This Enrichment seminar will cover the discovery of novel kinase inhibitors that mitigate pathological airway remodeling associated with asthma. Dr. Shapiro will discuss how ICTR resources helped generate preliminary data and NIH funding through the R61/R33 Catalyze program at the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute. The talk will also cover the goals of the Catalyze program and its role in promoting the development of new therapies and entrepreneurial activities.
